About this guide...

This guide is a compilation of 13,000+ prices collected from January 1990 to December 2012 (hence the subtitle, Crop 1212).

Books are organized by magicians' names. For each magician, books are presented in alphabetical order.

Each book has various data listed, grouped by decade. For the 1990s, 1,100+ prices were collected. For the 2000s, 6,800+ prices. And for the 2010s, up to December 2012, 5,200+ prices.

An abrupt price rise might mean that it's a worthwhile book that has recently gone out of print. On the other hand, a sharp decline might mean that a reprint just came out. The changes through time will also tell you if the value is now stable or still volatile.

E.V. stands for Estimated Value. This value was calculated by giving a weight to each collected price, according to source, the seller's reputation for having fair pricing, year the book was advertised, if the seller was in the USA, and, when part of an auction, if the book sold, the number of bids made and if there was a "Buy It Now" option. The letter that follows indicates how reliable the estimation is: Low, Medium or High. This reliability factor is governed by the number of collected prices and the weight described.

Note that lowest or highest prices have been dropped from the compilation. The same is true for books coming from prominent collections or offered by prestigious auctioneers.

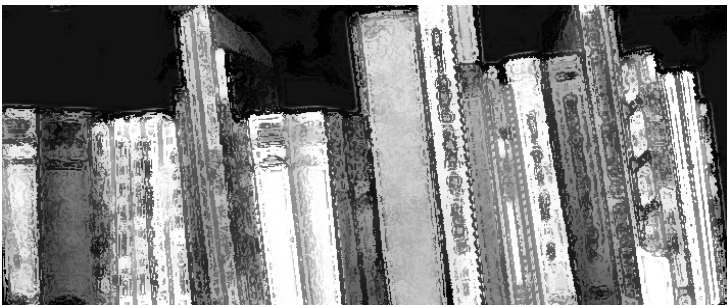
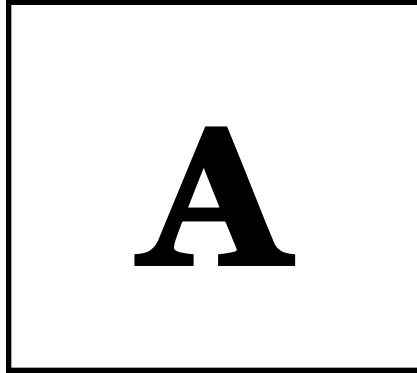
Most values of this guide are presented as a range from low to high; for example, \$6~31. The figures on left generally apply to softcover editions, recent editions or reprints. The figures on the right are for hardcover editions with dust jackets, first or deluxe editions and signed copies.

If you are looking to buy a certain work but are not in a hurry, aim for the figures on the left side. Otherwise, go for the figures on the right side.

If you are a seller eager to sell, aim for the figures on the left side. Otherwise, go for the figures on the right side.

Whatever the guide says, also consider your own evaluation.

Finally, this guide is also intended as a notebook. The check boxes, the white spaces and the kind of paper used are all invitations for your precious handwritten notes. When traveling, it makes a good companion for book hunting.
